<b>1</b>	Brighton and Hove City Council (BHCC) are continuing with their big review of SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disability) and BESD (Behavioural, Educational and Social Difficulties) provision for CYP aged 0-25. We have just found out that this is now going to be merged with the review of adults Learning Disabilities and we need to find out how this will work in practice.
<b>2</b>	A joint meeting of the Health and Well-being Board and Children's Committee met on the 3rd of February and all recommendations from the review so far were agreed. It was agreed that more work was needed around the proposals to create some 'Integrated Provision' for children with SEND at pre-school and school age and provision for BESD children and more detailed proposals will come back to these committees in the Summer.
<b>3</b>	BHCC held a conference on the 13th March to hear from 3 providers of outstanding integrated provision across the country and colleagues discussed what they would like to see developed in B&H. CVS colleagues have since met Regan Delf to discuss how the CVS can input to these ideas but these discussions are ongoing.
